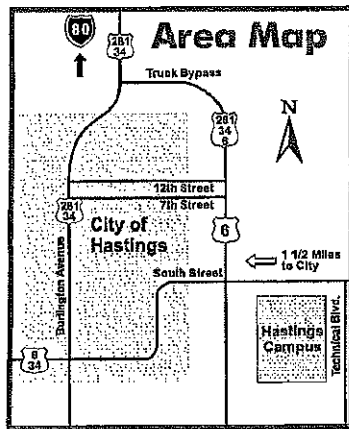

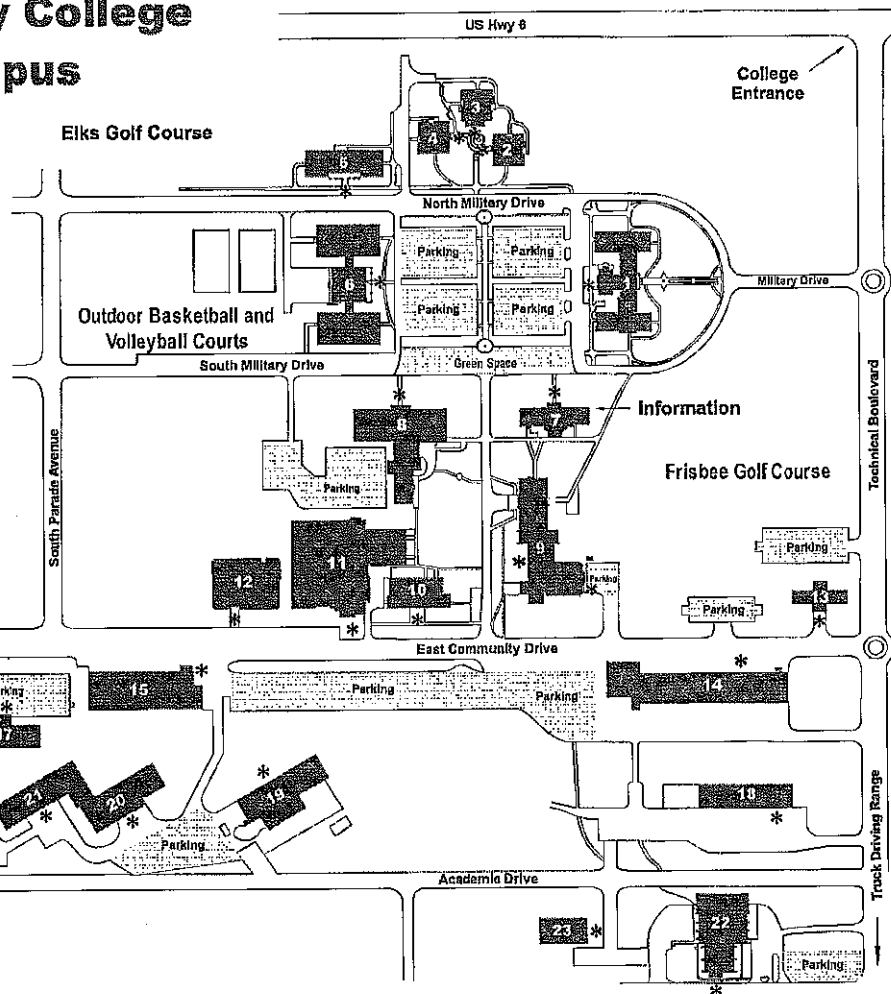

I am sending you some information in regards to the Sertoma Eight-Man All-Star Game and Camp in Hastings. The camp will be held on the campus of **Central Community College**, which is located 3 miles east of Hastings on Highway 6. We are staying in **Clay Hall**. I have included a map to the campus. **Check in time is between 11 a.m. and 12 p.m., on Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup>**. Please come in Shape!!

On **Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>**, there will be a barbecue picnic at **1:00 p.m.** held at Chautauqua Park after check out of the dorm. Your parents and family are invited to attend this picnic and we hope to see them there. Chautauqua Park is located at 2215 W. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Hastings, NE. **Each player will receive 4 free meal passes for their family. If you have more than 4 family and friends that want to attend, the cost will be \$5.00 per plate for the additional family and friends.**

Some things you will need to bring to Hastings with you:

- Bedding for a twin size bed
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, razor, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Towels
- A water bottle for in the dorms to continue to refill to stay hydrated throughout the week
- Some spending money (we can order pizza or stop at a fast food place every night)
- Casual clothing for events (you will wear either your game jersey or Sertoma T-shirt when we go out in Hastings, shorts will be fine on these occasions)
- Money for laundry facilities in the dorm
- Football Gear (please make sure your things are in good working order, like helmet snaps are OK, shoulder strap buckles, etc.)
- We will lend out game pants for the game on Saturday (If you have a clean white pair of pants that you want to bring with you, that is ok as well)
- Golf clubs, if you wish to golf you will have a couple of opportunities
- A swimming suit as we may have time to go to the water park
- Any medicines that you must take on a regular basis

After lunch on Monday, we will take team and individual pictures. We will provide you with a team picture at no charge to you. If you wish to purchase any individual picture(s), please fill out the envelope and include the appropriate amount of CASH. We will have the order forms at Hastings when you check-in.

Your parents will be able to meet you at the dorms on the day of the game anytime **before 11 a.m.** to pick up your belongings.
