Greg Austin – University of Nebraska

Coach Austin was a former offensive lineman at Nebraska and is in his first season coaching Offensive Line for the Huskers. During his playing career he was an honorable-mention All-Big 12 selection in 2006. Greg was also a two-time academic All-Big 12 selection for his classroom achievements. He has spent the last eight seasons coaching in the NFL and collegiate ranks. Greg, and his wife Kelley have three daughters Kilyn, Kenly, and Kolbe.

Barrett Ruud – University of Nebraska

Coach Ruud is in his first season with the Huskers and will be coaching the Inside Linebackers. He was previously the Quality Control Administrator at Central Florida. Coach Ruud was the 36th overall pick in the 2005 NFL Draft followed by a long career in the NFL with Tampa Bay, Tennessee, New Orleans, and Houston. Barrett, and his wife Jenna have one son Brooks.

Rod Brummels – Retired

Coach Brummels started his coaching career at Clearwater serving as assistant for three years and head coach for 28.
